

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

A.		Eligibility
1.	I neither studied in Tamil Nadu nor a native of Tamil Nadu. Can I apply?	No. You cannot apply under Tamil Nadu state quota. However, you can apply for All India quota (15 % seats) through the ICAR Quota. In addition, you can apply for B.Tech. (Biotechnology), BBA only under other state quota.
2.	I have studied Maths, Physics, Chemistry and Computer Science, but not biology. Can I apply for B.F.Sc. & B. Tech. (Biotechnology)?	No The subject 'Biology' (or) Botany and zoology together is essential for B.F.Sc. & B.Tech. (Biotechnology) degree programme in TNJFU.
3.	I have studied Maths, Physics, Chemistry and Computer Science, but not biology Can I apply for B.Tech (FE) & B. Tech. (FT)?	Yes
4.	I have studied Physics, Chemistry, Botany and Zoology. Can I apply for B. Tech. (FE) & B. Tech. (FT)?	No
5.	I have studied in Government aided school (from 6 th to 12 th standard). Am I eligible to avail 7.5% reservation for Government school students?	No. Private and Government aided schools are not eligible to avail 7.5% reservation under Government school students category.
6.	What will happen to my application, if my minimum eligible mark is lesser than required?	If you have scored the mark lesser than minimum requirement (under respective community / category) as eligible, your application will be rejected. Kindly refer the

		prospectus under section 3 Qualifying Examination and Minimum marks.
7.	I am one day or few days higher than the upper age limit, am I eligible to apply?	Kindly refer the prospectus under section 3.6 Age limit.
B.	Registration and Application	
8.	While doing registration, I have not received the OTP in email. How to proceed?	While doing registration of your email ID, please verify you have entered the email ID correctly. Kindly verify your email Inbox in all the Tabs (Primary, Promotions, Social, Updates, Forum and Spam) and check for OTP.
9.	What is my user's name?	Your registered email ID / mobile number will be your user name. Please make a note of these particulars and secure well for future reference and use for filling up options at the time of online counselling.
10.	Can I apply for all the courses (B.F.Sc., B.Tech., BBA & B.Voc.) in a single application?	Yes. Candidates can apply for all the courses (B.F.Sc., B.Tech., BBA & B.Voc.) simultaneously through single application, by clicking all the options and filling relevant information. Application fee is same for any number of courses.
11.	Can I submit more than one application for the same degree course? Or I made mistake or wrong entry in	No. A candidate can submit only one application using his / her registered mobile number and email. Please avoid duplicate entry. If you have made mistake or wrong entry,

If more than one application for the same degree programme is submitted, only one application will be considered for further processing. Application fee will not be refunded in any case.</p>
<p>12.</p>	<p>Can I edit my application after final submission?</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Or</p> <p>How to make correction of any wrong entry once the application is submitted?</p>	<p>Once the final submission of application / last date of submission is over, there will be a correction window, opened for 2-3 days after the last date of submission. The applicant can make the corrections, if entered wrong. However, the applicants are advised to be careful, while filling up of application format itself and check the particulars during preview of application before submission.</p>
<p>13.</p>	<p>I have submitted application for one degree programme (B.F.Sc.). Later, I want to apply for B.Tech. degree programme. Can I apply?</p>	<p>Yes.</p> <p>You can apply before the last date of submission of applications. Already used Mobile number and email ID for the first application cannot be used for the second application. Please note that all communications will be sent to the respective registered mobile number and email ID. Please regularly check for any communications in both the registered mobile number and email ID.</p>

14.	Whether any candidate can apply a fresh (with new application) during the correction window period?	No. New applications cannot be possible during the correction window period. Only corrections can be made by the applicant who has submitted the application earlier <i>i.e.</i> on or before the last date of submission of application.
15.	Should I also submit the printed copy of filled in application through post? (Or) Whether I have to come in person to submit the application?	No. The application for UG admission in TNJFU should be sent only through online mode. Hard copy of the application will not be accepted.
16.	If I applied for admission under special categories (Sports / Differently abled / Children of Ex-serviceman / Fishermen Quota or Government School students under 7.5 % reservation), am I eligible under general quota also?	Yes. You will be considered for both special and general categories. If you are eligible, you can verify your rank in separate rank lists released for general and respective special categories. Initially counselling will be conducted for special categories based on merit. If you don't get the seat under special category, you will be considered for General Category based on the rank. If you get the seat under both General and Special category, you can decide at that time based on the campus and fee.
17.	I have applied for B.F.Sc & B.Tech under Tamil Nadu state quota. I am	Yes. You can. All India quota seats will be processed by the ICAR through separate

19.	<p>In case of CBSE or Other Board, whether additional marks will be assigned for calculation of aggregate marks</p>	<p>Normalization procedure will be followed as specified in the Prospectus. If the highest marks in Tamil Nadu State Board and CBSE or Other Boards in each subject is 100%, then the marks secured in the subjects of different boards will be considered at par. Kindly refer the prospectus under section 3.5.2 normalization.</p>
C.	Payment	
20.	<p>There is problem in payment. I have paid the amount through online, but I did not receive any information about successful payment. But the amount is deducted in my bank account. How to resolve this issue. Whether I need to pay once again?</p>	<p>Generation of application numbers indicates the successful payment. If application number is not generated and amount is deducted in your bank account, the amount will be refunded within 7 bank working days to your account and your application will be in unsubmitted status. You have to make payment for generation of application. If amount is not refunded beyond the specified time period, please contact our technical team (Help desk) or bank.</p>

21.	Whether any concessions are available in application fee?	Yes. Application fee concessions are available for SC/SCA/ST categories (50% of application fee of General categories). Refer the Prospectus section 5. Instructions to fill online application.
22.	Whether application fee will be refunded for rejected applications? Or If I didn't get admission, whether application fee will be refunded?	No. Application once submitted, application fee will not be refunded on any grounds.
D.	Rank list and Counselling	
23.	When will the rank list be released? Or How do I know my rank?	The rank list will be released after processing of submitted applications and the rank list will be hosted in University website. Candidate may know their rank by searching their application number in the rank list.
24.	Even though, I got same aggregate mark, my rank is lower than the few candidates. What is the reason for it?	If the candidates' aggregate marks are equal, procedure for assessing in <i>Inter-se Merit</i> will be followed as mentioned in the Prospectus in section 5.3
25.	How do I know about the date of In-person / Online counselling?	Intimation will be sent to registered mobile number and email ID of the eligible candidates prior to the start of Counselling (online or in- person). They can also check the University website regularly for updates.
26.	For whom, the in-person/online counselling will be conducted?	Initially, In-person counseling will be conducted for candidates of Special category (Sports / Differently abled / Children of Ex- serviceman, Fishermen (5%,

		15%) NRI & Foreign Nation) and Government School students under 7.5 % reservation. For the rest of the candidates, the admission will be only through online counselling. Please keep checking the TNJFU website for updates.
27.	Whether the preference for college, entered once, can be changed?	In general, once the application with all necessary entries and enclosures is finally submitted, preferences cannot be changed. However, there will be a provision made for making changes in the application through opening of correction window, which will be given for 2-3 days after the last date of submission. During this period, the applicant can make the corrections (if any) in the entries. Similarly, there will be a chance to fill their preference of colleges during the registration of Online counselling.
28.	If I missed to register for online counselling, can I participate in subsequent round of online counselling?	No. If you are eligible for registration of online counselling (as mentioned in counselling cut-off) and missed to register within the stipulated date and time, you will not be considered for further counselling on any grounds.
29.	I got the allotment letter and I missed to pay the fee within the prescribed date and time due to personal or any other reason. Can I	No. Once you fail to report, submit the original certificates and pay the fee, it is not possible to join afterwards. It is because, if

	join after wards?	you fail to join, your vacant seat will be allotted to next eligible candidate. Also, you will not be considered for further counselling.
30.	If I belong to "BC / BCM / MBC / SC / SCA / ST" category, Am I eligible under OC?	Yes. You will be considered in OC based on merit. Once seats under OC are filled, you will be considered under respective communities based on merit.
31.	I got the seat in least preferred college. Will I get the seat in the preferred college in future?	Yes, depending upon the generated vacancy and your merit. Already admitted candidates can participate for internal counselling for Change of campus. Those who got first preferred campus, are not permitted for Internal counselling.
32.	I have already joined in "XXXX College". I am having original HSC mark sheet, but not having my original Transfer Certificate. But I have original Bonafide certificate from the joined college. Can I join in the Fisheries College using the Bonafide certificate in case of selection?	Till participation in counselling, Bonafide certificate is accepted. However, if you are selected and got allotment letter, you need to report and submit all original certificates including original TC (Transfer Certificate) before the stipulated date and time. In that case, you will be allowed for admission / fee payment only with the Original TC. Bonafide certificate will not be accepted for fee payment.
33.	Is it possible to interchange the college with my friend/relative /any other person after admission?	It is not possible. Campus change is possible only through internal counselling through registration. Based on the order of merit and preference, campus change will be made.

E.	NRI Quota	
34.	In NRI quota, whether, friends of my parents, nephew / niece or blood relative's spouse can act as the NRI sponsorer?	No. Candidate's direct blood relative viz., Own brother / own sister / father / mother / own brother or sister of father or own brother or sister of mother can only act as NRI sponsorer for NRI quota.
F.	Others	
35.	Is there any private Fisheries Colleges affiliated to TNJFU in Tamil Nadu?	Yes St. Devasahayam Institute of Fisheries Science & Technology, Midalam, Kanniyakumari District.
36.	Whether any management quota is available in TNJFU UG admission?	Yes. Management seats are available in Private affiliated college only.
37.	I am unable to study in a particular campus due to medical grounds or any other grounds. Can I migrate to other colleges after opening of college or in consecutive years?	No. It is not possible to migrate from one college to other college on any grounds.
38.	Whom I have to contact for any queries while filling-up the application?	Kindly read the prospectus in the respective sections carefully. In case of further queries, you can send email to admissionug@tnfu.ac.in for any clarification. Or Contact the help desk through the given phone number during the mentioned time period.
